This two-week period started with six assigned personnel and then increased to eight crew members during week two. Hurricane Irma came during the second week on September 10<sup>th</sup> and fortunately only caused three days of lost progress. The crew accomplished storm preparations on September 8<sup>th</sup> and in the wake of Irma reset the stages at the west bedroom drops of the 01 stack on September 12<sup>th</sup>. As of September 15<sup>th</sup>, windows have been installed at the elevator lobbies from the 22<sup>nd</sup> floor down to the 12<sup>th</sup> floor.

With a second swing stage in place at the west-facing, 01 stack, new ES windows are replacing the Pella 8000T windows in the guest bedrooms in Units 2201 and 2101. This stage will stay at the 01 stack and move in a downward direction replacing the called for windows at the various guest bedrooms. The gypsum board has been installed at the interior kneewall at the 22<sup>nd</sup> floor and a white Corian sill will follow to complete the replacement components. The popcorn ceiling application has been applied inboard of the new windows from the 22<sup>nd</sup> floor down to the 16<sup>th</sup> floor.
